During the financial year 2014-15, UDAAN Society had been involve in following major activities. The detail of which is given below.

### **Childline**

During the year the childline has expanded its horizon and supported more childline who are in need of care and support then the previous year. To reach out the each and every single person childline has organized 50 group meetings, awareness generation about the 1098 among masses, liaison with the allied system and conducted responsive child awareness programmes, identified the child labour cases and rescued them. The coordinated efforts of child line has changed life of children residing at railway station or road side. Over all we have supported 196 children during the year in which children who were restored are 152, medical help of one child and 43 children got shelter.

### **Pehal**

Pehal is the collaborative project of UDAAN Society and Population Service international (PSI), Delhi office. The Pehal project serves woman who are in need of family planning services in urban area. The project was implemented at Khurja town of Bulandshar district. The project was started on 15<sup>th</sup> April 2014 and during the year we have provided family planning service to 636 woman who were interested in IUCD insertion. The team of trained doctor along with UDAAN Society professional who are expert in mobilization was able to achieve this target with the support of PSI.



### **Urban Health Initiative**

UDAAN Society has successfully entered into fifth consecutive year of Urban Health Initiative Project (UHI) supported by Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. The BMGF through a consortium of International organizations has initiated this project. The NGOs like UDAAN Society is working as implementing partners in the project. During the year we have implemented project in 110 urban slums of Aligarh city with 223 field and office staff. The major objective of the project to reduce Maternal and Child Mortality through Family Planning. The programme is very much successful as we have provided family planning services to more than 10,000 people including woman of reproductive age and male through vasectomy (Male sterilization).

### **Water and Sanitation**

Since its inception UDAAN Society is committed to the water and sanitation issue. We have started our work with UNICEF in Firozabad district. Since then we have



not looked back when it comes to water and Sanitation issue. This year we have also continued our work with Department of Panchayat Raj, district Hathras and supported worked in 6 aspect of WAS in 75 Lohiya villages of the district.

### **Micro nutrient Training**

UDAAN Society in Association with Gorakhpur Environmental Action Group (GEAG) has initiated Micro nutrient training to Anganwadi worker and ANM in the six districts of Aligarh and Agra division. The project was funded by Micro Nutrient Initiative, an International organization working for children and adolescent girls. During the year we have given training to the Anganwadi workers of Hathras and Firozabad and ANM of Agra and Firozabad district.. The other four districts will be covered in the subsequent year. The Anganwadi workers were trained on Vitamin A supplement , Iron, Zinc, ORS, Iodine and conducting session during '*Bal Swasthya Poshan Mah*'.



During the year a total of 3796 Anganwadi worker and 205 ANM of both district were trained.

### **Handicraft**

UDAAN Society is committed to the handicraft artisans who are involved in making woman *Kurtis* and are not able to market their products due to lack of awareness about the market and opportunities. UDAAN Society has served 100 of artisans in their work and helped in marketing of their products on reasonable rates. During the year we have done marketing for woman artisanal *Kurtis* in different states of the country. By these efforts we have supported families of the artisans and helped in earning bread and butter for them.

### **Investors Awareness Programme**

UDAAN Society is implementing partner of Tikсна Mission Trust to conduct an Investor awareness programme under the Social Initiative of National Stock Exchange. This is the kind of opportunity that share thoughts on an area of concern that affects almost all of us.

The Program would comprise a presentation related to saving, financial planning, precautions and the dos and don'ts of investing, general awareness about the stock market, NSE Products and education initiative of NSE.

IAP is a social activity and is conducted purely creating awareness amongst the masses. The beneficiaries attending the IAP of the institution/ organisation where is conducted are not required to pay any money of these program.

### **Hot Cooked project**

Under this project the fund is provided by the ICDS department of Uttar Pradesh to implement hot cooked food project at blocks of Districts Hathras, Etawah, Jhansi, Badaun, Hardoi & Kashganj. Organization prepare the cooked meal as per the menu for the day and supply it to the respective Anganwadi centres in the designated blocks. The issue of Hygeine and sanitation is taken into consideration while preparing and supply of the prepared food.

### Old Age Home

UDAAN Society has provided a 6 room hall at the famous Khereswar Temple of Aligarh to run the old age and children home there. The organization is in the process of maintaining these room and creating some infrastructural facilities so that the needy old age people can be stay and get medical support over there. The generous society of Aligarh is also supporting us in this cause.



As we have seen many old age people and children pushes to reside on road side due to the meager condition and in absence of any such governmental facility. The organization is of the view that such facility should be started as soon as possible.

### Project Shakti



Project Shakti is the initiative of the UDAAN Society to train adolescent girls and woman in sewing cutting and tailoring so that they can get employment opportunities near to their home and stand on their own feet.

The organization has started three such training centre at Pala Sahibabad and Nagla Masani.

The trained woman were provided with certificates from the organization so that they can grab the opportunity more easily.

### UDAAN Classes At Borna

Started on 5th of November 2014, UDAAN CLASSES is a project run by UDAAN Society in the nearby village of Borna. The purpose of UDAAN Classes is to provide supportive education to the children who cannot bear the loads of tuition and lagging behind



others in the school. The children are selected from meagre background and daily, one hour education is provided to them by the well trained teachers in the same locality.

UDAAN Society equipped the place with infrastructure and giving a honorarium to the teachers so that quality educational support to the children who have potential to do well in their schools cannot lag behind to other students just because of support and guidance.

UDAAN Classes has a single motto to cover the rural areas where there is chunk of potential to grow and to do better among students.
